



The mission of the PeaceJam Foundation is to create a new generation of young leaders committed to positive change in themselves, their communities, and the world through the inspiration of Nobel Peace Laureates. PeaceJam is a non-profit organization with its international headquarters located in Arvada, Colorado.

What is a PeaceJam Intern or Volunteer?

PeaceJam interns and volunteers (a) assist with implementing PeaceJam Programs in school, after school, and community based settings and/or (b) provides office and program support for the PeaceJam Foundation staff. Interns and volunteers must be 13-years-old or older. Applications are accepted at any point throughout the year. The difference between becoming a PeaceJam Intern versus a PeaceJam Volunteer is that interns have a more structured work plan and often receive credit for their work in a school setting. Intern work plans are aligned to meet their educational or professional goals.

How much time is involved in interning or volunteering for PeaceJam?

The PeaceJam Foundation and Rocky Mountain PeaceJam have intern and volunteer opportunities ranging from 1 to 40 hours/week depending on the site or position. Some of these positions require set schedules and some may be flexible to fit the needs of the intern.

Benefits of Interning and Volunteering at the PeaceJam Foundation:

Though PeaceJam internships and volunteer opportunities are unpaid, there are a number of benefits to working with us:

- A once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to work with youth and Nobel Peace Laureates with an international organization that was itself nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize in 2008
- Extensive training and select PeaceJam Conference admission at no cost
- A unique experience to put on your resume
- An opportunity to tangibly make a difference in the world and your community

Required Training:

The PeaceJam Foundation provides all necessary training for PeaceJam interns and volunteers. The amount of training depends on the position and may include a specific training session or training on the job.

Other Requirements:

PeaceJam is required to conduct a criminal background check for each intern or volunteer to ensure the safety of the youth involved in PeaceJam Programs. The results of the background check will be kept confidential. Prior felonies or misdemeanors classified as offenses against a person or family, or public indecency may disqualify you from interning with the PeaceJam Foundation.

Application Deadlines:

Most PeaceJam internship and volunteer positions are available on a continuous basis and there is no deadline for applying. Complete the following application return by scan and email, mail, or fax to:
